Cold War, Korean War (political and international - can cover causes of Vietnam War)

Fourth Nine Weeks

Post War - Truman, Eisenhower years - social and cultural
JFK, LBJ - New Frontier, Great Society, key points of Civil Rights Movement and Vietnam War
