Student needs (not given to teacher):

- 1 – student assignment book – to be purchased at school
- 1 - three ring binder 2" or 3"
- 1– pencil bag
- 1– set of notebook dividers for student binder

Supplies given to teachers: Students can give these supplies to their teachers during open house or on the first day of school. Please label the bag containing their supplies with your child's first and last name, as student schedules sometimes do change after the first day of school.

- 3 – packages of a dozen #2 pencils or mechanical pencils (1) Student keeps (2) homeroom teacher (His or her homeroom teacher will house two of the packages, so students have pencils in the classroom throughout the school year)
- 2 – packages of notebook paper – **wide ruled only** (1) Student keeps (1) homeroom teacher
- 1- package of lined white flashcards
- 4- composition books – (1) Language Arts (2) Science (1) Math
- 1- three ring 1" or 1.5" binder (Social Studies)
- 3 – bottles of glue (1) Science (2) homeroom teacher
- 2 - rolls of paper towels (Science)
- 1 – package of blue or black pens (Student may choose to keep some and give some to HR teacher)
- 1 – pair of scissors (homeroom teacher)
- 2 – packages of markers (homeroom teacher)
- 2 – packages of 12 colored map pencils (homeroom teacher)
- 3 - boxes of tissues (homeroom teacher)
- 1 – packages of construction paper (homeroom teacher)
- 1 – package of highlighters (different colors)

**There are some supplies which students will need to replenish, as needed, throughout the school year. With teachers holding onto majority of the supplies, the need for students to replenish supplies has decreased.

**No backpacks are allowed in the classroom. These are kept in the students' lockers. It is recommended that students have a lock for their locker.

**It is also recommended, but not required, that students have an inexpensive flash drive. This will allow students to work on classroom computer projects at home. These may be ordered through the school store in the cafeteria. If you choose to purchase a flash drive from an outside source, make absolutely certain that it does NOT contain any preloaded software programs, as the GISD system will block access. The up-keep of flash drives will be the responsibility of the student. Tippit will not be responsible for lost and damaged flash drives.
